

Save time and pay less for college. The Early College Access Program (ECAP) allows you to save 50% on tuition for any qualifying credit course. High school juniors and seniors 16 and older with at least a 2.0 grade point average are urged to apply!

The 30-minute Zoom sessions will give you the chance to meet one-on-one with an AACC admissions officer to help you determine eligibility, ask questions, select classes and register for the summer and/or fall 2021 term.

Be sure to have this checklist done before your scheduled session:

CHECKLIST:

- First, if you haven't applied to AACC, <u>submit</u> your application for admission. You will then receive instructions for setting up a MyAACC account.
- ☐ Go to <u>aacps.org/ecap</u> to view the ECAP Application form.
- Provide your AACPS username and password and the form will populate with your student information. If you need help accessing the form, email AACPS at **help-desk@aacps.org**.
- Print and complete the ECAP Application form at <u>aacps.org/ecap</u>. The student, parent and high school representative must sign the form.
- Send the completed ECAP Application to AACC's **cashier's office**. Eligible students will have the 50% tuition reduction applied to their bill. Be sure to white out/scratch off your birth year, leaving only the day and month visible.
- Send a copy of your high school transcript to AACC's records office.
- Determine placement. Do you need to take the Accuplacer? Attend a Personal Registration Day (PRD) Placement Seminar hosted by the testing center to find out. **Register to attend** before participating in PRD at your high school.
- □ Good news! Financial assistance is available through the **Early College Access Grant (ECAG)** for students who can demonstrate financial need. Complete the application and send it to AACC's **financial aid** department. Eligible students will receive \$200 in the fall term and \$200 in the spring term.
